



Exercise - not many people love it, but everyone needs it. We need to renew our strength.

Working in a chiropractic office for seven years, I learned the importance of exercise and nutrition. Incorporating that importance with my Christian upbringing (my parents were ministers) fostered my joy in helping others.

I do not like traditional gyms and neither does my husband. We were introduced to therapeutic toning tables, and we were very impressed with the results. The toning tables move you while you push and work with them to get the best results. Using these tables is a unique way to exercise. It is very low impact and works well for people with limitations such as heart or stroke problems, diabetes, high blood pressure, leg or vein problems, swelling, respiratory problems, injuries and for those who have had surgery.

After praying about a name, we decided in 2015 on RENEW Fitness Center. The idea came from Isaiah 40:31 (NKJV), "Those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings as eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint." We added cardio, rehab equipment, an Infrared sauna, a relaxation area and more. We wanted a place where people could exercise on safe equipment, enjoy the peaceful and motivating atmosphere, and get good results.

We have scriptures on the walls, a prayer request book for those who want or need prayer, and Christian music (or oldies) plays most of the time. By providing Christian literature and Bibles for customers to read and sending out encouragement cards to those having difficulties, we offer a positive, nurturing environment. At Renew Fitness there is much laughter and everyone encourages each other.

We don't have to live our lives in poor health. The aging process can cause a series of health issues with our bodies. The earlier you start working on preventing these issues, the better quality of life you will experience. I tell our customers that they can do more of what God has called them to do and can enjoy the life He gave them more if they are feeling better.

Health is not just physical. Many people come center hurting physically emotionally. I listen to them talk about their emotional issues, which sometimes adds to their physical pains. People need to know that someone cares and wants to help. They need person who practices patience and encouragement for them. Each customer receives my help on the level they can work and we progress to more as they are able. Our customers work on different levels and their abilities improve over time so ultimately they can work as hard as they want. One customer commented that she was glad she could now kneel at church, and another customer's husband said since she had been coming to Renew Fitness, she was much happier. Some customers say exercise with us has helped them to enjoy their grandkids more, and many are able to travel more.

There are many benefits to exercising. Some just need a little push of encouragement that we offer to help them improve.

Many of our customers have been an encouragement and help to us in our ministry. We are so thankful for each one we serve and who helps us in ministry. Our customers' age span is pretty impressive: our youngest is 23 and the oldest is 91!

Our heart to help people extends beyond physical fitness. Throughout the year we contribute to organizations such as Healing Hands Ministry (funding the construction of an orphanage in Kenya), Toys for Tots and Meals on Wheels recipients (Christmas gifts), goodie bags for a women's shelter in Atlantam and more.



Steppin' Out Performing Arts, located in downtown Newnan, provides instruction in dance, acting, music and more for children ages 0-adult. Founded in 2017 by Cassie Jackson and myself, the studio started as a remote company using local parks and recreation for our classes. We quickly grew and moved into our first, one-room studio home in Newnan.

I actually started my relationship with the studio as a parent. We were new to the area, and I did a lot of research about the type of studio with which I wanted my family to be a part. My background is as a performer and teacher, and I had previously run a children's performing arts company in Atlanta. Steppin' Out greatly appealed to me because of the types of the programs they offered and the strategic way they focused on growing and nurturing their students. Once I met Cassie, I quickly learned of her heart for others and for Jesus and also saw her passion for the arts and the community. Jesus, the arts, and community are three things that speak to me, too. Even during the pandemic, the growth of the studio continued, and Cassie approached me to join her as a business partner. My husband and I prayed about this and felt like the Lord was opening a door for our family.



Cassie and I, both being believers, feel like the Lord has called us to be a light in the community and to lead with His wisdom, mercy, and grace. John 8:12 (ESV) says, "Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." We have the blessing to share our passion for the arts with the youth of today and to encourage and teach them-not just in skills and technique, but in life lessons. Our daily prayer is that our love for Christ is apparent. As Christians, our worldview and approach to teaching are a part of this. We deeply care about our studio families and want them to feel the love and joy we hope to bring them when they walk in the door. Developing meaningful relationships with families and praying for and with them also is important to us. We also take into consideration and special care the types of music, costume, and themes we use within our studio. We've been given such an incredible opportunity to use our gifts, and we both feel very blessed to be serving God's kingdom in this way.

Our studio has continued to grow, and we moved last year into a three-studio space in downtown Newnan. This buildout was very intense, and our families were great to step in and help us along the way. We were so excited to be able to open our doors to even more families and more opportunities for the community that we both love so much. We have several performing groups within our studio (Musical Theatre Ensemble and Company) that perform at local events in and around Newnan. It's exciting to give these students opportunities to let their lights shine, too. We offer ballet, tap, jazz, musical theatre, hip-hop, acro, contemporary, acting, private piano and voice ... and the list goes on! Our younger ballet program is unique in that we offer what we call fairytale ballet. Every two weeks the ballerinas not only learn technique and skills, but also they hear a story and get to dress up in costumes and dance. Those little ballerinas love this as it engages them in a fun way. We also have instructors certified in Acrobatic Arts and Music Together and are world-renowned able teach their curriculums at our studio. The Acrobatic Arts curriculum focuses on flexibility, strength, balance, limbering and tumbling. It is taught very carefully, allowing children to progress in these areas safely. Music Together is an early childhood music and movement program that focuses on music education and child development in a practical and creative way.

We are also in the process of getting approval to start programs in several of the local elementary schools. This will be an incredible outreach opportunity for our studio to bring the arts to local schools.

We love to offer our space for other events and have allowed local churches to use the space when needed. We also hosted a holiday market last November for Newnan's Small Business Saturday to allow local artisans and vendors a place to share and display their beautiful art and handmade goodies. It was a great way to meet people in our community who came in to shop and learn about the studio while also opening up our space for the vendors to get needed exposure and business. Ever looking for ways to evolve and meet new people with whom we can share God's love, we're also in talks now with a local yoga teacher about offering classes and offering the proceeds to benefit different local ministries.



CREATIVELY SHARING GOD'S HEART

I recently told someone that Creative Heart Studio was my gift from God containing only the things I loved to do and none of the things I did not! My joys include spending time with God, sharing my faith, pointing people who hurt to God, the One True Healer, helping others and being creative.

In 2016 I experienced what I called a breakdown. I felt I would not survive, but in truth it was a shaking up of my nest. It moved me toward much-needed healing from childhood trauma and away from a manipulative marriage that included placing two children up for adoption.

God has made me aware that eagles pad their nests with soft items to comfort their newborns; as the eaglets grow, the mother begins to remove the padding from the nest, revealing uncomfortable sticks and rough objects so that the eaglets are ready to leave.

I had made a bubble around my life for awhile - a safe place for me to exist. My bubble developed slow leaks, and finally when it burst in 2017, I was a mess.

I had always packed away the past and moved forward, but now I was letting it all out. Every single time that I shared anything I had experienced, other women came to me and shared their own experiences. I cried out to God to give me the words to say to them, and He answered me. I was led to a group that had an excellent program for women who had been through domestic violence and abuse. I took classes from a local counseling center including pastoral counseling and life coaching, as well as online seminary and life coaching classes, and I became certified to teach. God allowed me to add art therapy to the mix of classes because I am by nature a creative person. He also led me to create healing pieces of art that I am able to use to tell others of His goodness and mercy.

The Bible says 'so that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God' in 2 Corinthians 1:8 (KJV). God has been showing me ways to do this for others.

I started a women's group at my local church, but several other opportunities presented themselves and led me toward the center we now occupy. As Creative Heart Studio, we share space inside Happy Life Nutrition in downtown Newnan. We have a nook for women to come for one-to-one talks. Bible studies, Chronic Joy studies for women with chronic illness, and Her Journey groups for those from a history of abuse. We host workshops for natural alternatives like essential oils and herbs, have art therapy programs, and offer a community crafting time. We have a small selection of Christian gifts such as jewelry, cups, journals, devotionals, and small decorative items. Our nook is small, but it is utilized well. When we have a gathering too big for the studio, we move it into the dining room at Happy Life.



We were blessed to start a local radio show in January 2022. When 2021 ended, I would have told you with much certainty that I would never do anything like a radio show. I did not like being in the spotlight or talking on microphones. But the Lord different plans and our program started with a solo show of me sharing my testimony and the mission of our network. Now I look forward to Thursday mornings when I record each week. We have a network of women share their who resources information, tying in a Biblical aspect to every show. After the show airs, we turn the discussion into a podcast that is widely circulated online. We also featuring different begun members and their areas of expertise in workshops; details about them can be found on our Facebook page. Our women's network also prepares and distributes "blessing bags" to diverse groups of women each month. These bags contain oil samples, lotions, herbal teas, and small treats. We include coupons from and information about the groups and businesses involved, and we always provide scripture and inspirational messages. As of the beginning of May 2022 we have distributed more than 1500 bags in the Newnan area.

Since our focus is primarily on women with most of our activities, we have started the Coweta Christian Business Owners
Directory to include our Christian brothers and sisters and their businesses that will benefit our clients.

This online and print directory features local businesses which are put through a vetting process with references to make sure our clients receive dependable Christian service from the providers we list.



God is blessing us in many areas. Our mission is to be a light that shines on the path to Him for others who need healing or just a little more joy and peace in their lives. We get to do this daily and enjoy ourselves while we go about His business.



He has moved so many people into my life through these activities, and I am amazed each time to see what He has planned. Please come visit us. We always have something going on, and we enjoy having new people drop in. **WWP**

A PLACE AT THE TABLE

"The more I have matured in my faith, the more I have begun to understand that the power of connecting table experiences is sacred by God's design."

In Ancient Hebrew culture during the days of Jesus, daily meals were essential to family and community life. Without modern conveniences, the women of the family spent the bulk of their days preparing the family's food from scratch. As men worked at their craft or in the fields, women faithfully ground wheat, made bread, and drew water from wells. The food they prepared wasn't necessarily fancy or extravagant, but it was imbued with care and love. Meal times provided a respite from work and a chance to connect, share stories, and reinvigorate strength. Gathering around the family table acted as the cornerstone of cultural connection. That is sadly not true much anymore in our current society.

Even so, while I am neither Hebrew nor ancient, I was blessed to grow up in a family that prioritized sharing meals around a table. No matter how busy my mother and father were, they kept our family dinners sacred.

Like the ancient Hebrews, the food wasn't necessarily fancy or extravagant, yet the connecting conversation was rich. For the brief hour or so that dinner spanned, time stopped, and the six of us could truly connect. We discussed the activities of the day, the heartbreaks and victories facing our family, and our upcoming adventures. We shared belly laughs about inside jokes that only our little brood would understand.

Those table exchanges were the lifeblood of my family and a legacy that my parents gifted to me and my three siblings. In fact, the more I have matured in my faith, the more I have begun to understand that the power of connecting table experiences is sacred by God's design. Yet, this type of table-based connection has become more and more neglected culturally. We spend our days hustling, rushing, and relying on fast food while we binge-watch our favorite shows. That's a far cry from the care, love, and hospitality of a family dinner table.

The COVID19 pandemic that caught the world by surprise in 2020 highlighted this fault line in our culture. Especially during the original shutdown phase, families were forced to be at home together and were isolated from all outside sources of community. While for countless families this brought about an unhealthy and toxic situation, for many others it was an unexpected invitation towards health and connection.

The shutdown forced many parents to actually sit down at the table with their children and enjoy a meal together. For the first time in many decades, the family table was used for more than a dumping ground for book bags and purses. During one of the hardest times our planet had ever experienced, families were reconnecting around their tables. If you think about it, few things are true for the large majority of people. My husband, Jason, and I believe that one thing is true for all people: there are certain benchmark events which deserve a celebration and company to witness them. Our business, Next Level Agency, is set up to help create those celebration moments, and our story is pretty unique.

It all started for me about 22 years ago when I was asked to sing and play piano at someone's wedding. Then I was asked again for another. And again. After being a part of a few weddings as a musician, it opened my eyes to how many other pieces and parts there were to weddings. Fast forward a few years, and I am sitting in a home working on floral arrangements with my mom and then-fiance, Jason, for a wedding that my mom was working on. We were working with my mom to make some money to save for our own wedding for which we were preparing.

Another layer of this rolled in when Jason, who is a local pastor, began officiating weddings for the students who were in his college ministry at the time. From there, we met some people who owned wedding venues and started connecting with them and even working for them when we could. We looked at it as building relationships, never thinking that it would develop into a business. I didn't realize it at the time, but God was working even then to birth what we now know as Next Level Agency.







Since 2017, our Next Level Agency team has been creating events and environments to help people celebrate special moments. It started out with a couple of weddings here and there and has blossomed into a full-scale event planning business specializing in weddings and parties. We offer event planning and day-of coordination. We also offer floral, decor, officiating, and a few other services upon request, provided using several reputable local vendors who specialize in the areas of cakes, catering, photography, videography, and hair and makeup.

We formalized the business in 2019 after a few weddings in the years prior to that where I was either a day-of coordinator or a full planner for the event. What sets us apart from the rest is that we build relationships with our clients and take care of all the details of the events so that clients and their families don't have to. With our background in ministry, it has been easy to see God working behind the scenes and bringing people to us who not only need our business - but also who need what we have to offer as people.

It really is a ministry. I find myself walking through situations with families - helping them to navigate the relationship side of events and weddings. It really is amazing what it does for our clients to just have someone with whom to talk, or for a mom to be able to express her feelings about her only daughter getting married and moving away. Or for a bride whose parents have passed away and who needs someone with whom to discuss plans.

It is in those moments, one after another, where God allows me and our team to be used in a more significant way than making flowers for the event or executing the timeline of the day. We even help with premarital counseling for couples who desire it in the days leading up to their wedding.

I also believe in being budget-conscious. I definitely do not want anyone going into debt by planning their event. I always strive to help make the event the most cost-efficient while at the same time making it look like everything that you have dreamed about.

One of my favorite things about our business is the team that we have created to make these events happen. Many of our employees are single moms, or stay-at-home moms and a dad, who are supplementing their income without having a day-to-day job on top of what they have at home. Several of our team members attend church with us and are relatively new to faith or are returning to church after some time away.

Another way that we see God moving is the ability that we have had to now give more back to our community. For the last several years, we have been able to donate to causes that we care deeply about that we would not have been able to otherwise. In particular, we have been able to give significantly to our church's yearly Golf Tournament that raises funds for Teacher Care and Student Care in our school system here in Coweta County.













I would love to see our business continue to grow and to set an example in an industry that is often all about how much money you can make. Our goal is to continue to love on people during their moments of celebration by taking care of the tough parts to give them the ability to celebrate. We also will continue to take care of our team who makes it all happen, and as we continue to build relationships with some of the best vendors around.

NEW BEGINNINGS: HELPING KIDS SOAR BEYOND THEIR CIRCUMSTANCES

Created in 2014, New Beginnings is a 501(c)3, nonprofit organization that assists under-served youth in Coweta County. Our organization provides food, clothing, shelter, school supplies and transportation to/from work/job interviews. Our goal is to meet the physical, social and emotional needs of those aged 14-19 who seek assistance. Our vision is "That America's youth - regardless of color, creed, and socioeconomic status - all be given the same opportunity to learn, live, and achieve beyond the boundaries that have been unknowingly set while also learning the importance of giving back to others."

While we assisted countless numbers of teens within our first three years of operation, we felt we hadn't achieved the impact we desired nor touched the lives of all the youth we knew we could reach in our community.

As a result, the New Beginnings Board of Directors and I went back to the drawing board, seeking God's direction for our organization through dedicated fasting and prayer. As a result, we decided to create and offer a tuition-free, outdoor summer youth camp, and that became one of the GREATEST decisions we would ever make. Camp New Beginnings is geared toward children aged 6-12. Meeting at least one or more of the qualifications from our non-profit criteria list, camp attendees come from single parent households, lower income households, homes where grandparents are raising their grandchildren, and other situations that typically put stress on children and limit their social and emotional development. We have become known especially for hosting this camp.

Camp New Beginnings became an instant success! Why? Because it attracted excited children who normally would spend their summer breaks at home alone or with friends or family while their parents went to work. Campers meet new and diverse friends, explore the great outdoors, and have the opportunity to swim twice a week. Camp hours run from 9am - 5pm, Monday through Friday, and the activities occur all summer long.

Camp New Beginnings reintroduces disadvantaged youth to the great outdoors all day, getting them back into nature and what God created us to enjoy. Because we want campers' full attention and participation all day, we created a no cell phone policy. Their activities include field trips, arts and crafts, recreational time, fishing, hiking, camping, and horseback riding.











Our daily camp routine is as follows: after breakfast is served, our prayer circle is in order.

Then we stretch to get our minds, attitude and body ready for another very active day outdoors. Mondays include camping, hiking, or fishing. Tuesdays are ball field and pool day. Wednesdays are our "Great Adventure" field trip day. On Thursdays, we as a group volunteer in the community, and Friday activities are a repeat of Monday's. Our Wednesday field trips include visits to theme parks, arcades, horseback riding, canoeing, media broadcasting offices, and a list of many other places.

Each participating camper/family has a corporate or individual sponsor that is arranged through New Beginnings. Most often the families don't know who their sponsor is, but they are extremely grateful and realize that their sponsor's generosity keeps the program worry-free for the adults who ordinarily might not be able to budget for such a luxury as an all-expenses paid summer camp experience for their camper/s.

Previous camp sponsorship donors included Mr. Otis, Piedmont Paving Inc.(PPI), American Legion Post 57, Dunkin' Donuts in Sharpsburg, Newnan Utilities, Family Patterns Matter, Newnan Walmart, Newnan Target, Papa John's on Temple Avenue, Welcome Farms, Firehouse Subs, City Of Newnan's Lynch Park, and YMCA Lynch Pool.

New Beginnings was birthed from the seed of an idea given to me by then-superintendent of Coweta County Schools, Dr. Steve Barker, who also was my former high school principal. I had taken custody of my deceased aunt's four children after her death.

At first they'd lived with their grandmother, but it wasn't working out well: they were skipping school and coming in late at night. Because I worked inside the jail at the Coweta County Sheriff's Department, my mom and grandmother both thought my home would be a better fit for them. When I met with Dr. Barker to enroll the children in school, he heard their story and saw my determination for them to succeed. He felt my guidance could benefit other children – others needed this same help that I was giving my family members.

Because we are a non-profit organization, every aspect of our operation gives back to the community.



We look forward to another year of helping children and young adults through our year-round programs, assistance and activities, and also by providing Camp New Beginnings for disadvantaged children (ages 6-12). God's principles for life also are good for business. In God Is My CEO, author, speaker and executive coach Larry Julian gives real-life illustrations and case studies of successful, Fortune 500 executives (and others) who have incorporated time-tested, biblical principles to lead and grow their companies and the people who work for them.

Often it takes a situation beyond the control of a leader to make it clear that God desires to guide them. "Your work is important to God. Your calling lasts a lifetime. Your work serves a purpose beyond yourself. And the significance of your work is eternal," Julian notes. Conoco Executive Archie Dunham agrees: "Following God's plan is the ultimate win-win solution. Of course, we don't use God for our success; He uses our talents for His purposes."

The book is 320 pages and addresses specific challenges common to both large and small businesses. Discussed are overarching biblical principles that tie to those challenges, and personal stories of executives across a multitude of fields and disciplines who have successfully integrated their faith and applied principles that helped their companies, their shareholders, their employees, and their customers. Each chapter features two case studies, a synopsis of what was learned by the executive as he/she worked through the issue, a conclusion, and discussion questions to consider individually or in a group.

You'll discover leadership secrets and work-life balance principles from corporate executives (whose names you may or may not know) of Chick-Fil-A, Popeye's Louisiana Kitchen, The Ritz Carlton, The ServiceMaster Company, United Health Group, and more. Sports leaders like Tony Dungy, former head coach of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, Leslie Frazier, head coach of the Minnesota Vikings, and Jerry Colangelo, former owner of the Phoenix Suns and the Arizona Diamondbacks discuss the importance of leading with character in order to win in the workplace and on the court/field. Even a former governor and congressman, Al Quie of Minnesota, shares how, while in office, he determined to overcome the "us vs. them" mentality so often found in politics. He advises, "Amazing things happen if individuals can operate as Jesus did."

Subject areas addressed in the first ten chapters include: Purpose, Success, Courage, Patience, Leadership By Example, Yielding Control, Servant Leadership, Love, Priorities and Redemption. The final chapter walks readers through the development of both a business plan AND a personal, professional and spiritual development plan. You'll consider scripture passages to guide your leadership, and you'll work through related steps to put your knowledge into action. Especially helpful is a section on choosing strategic partnerships to help you and your plan succeed. While many people choose to lead "Lone Ranger" style, Julian explains, "Sooner or later we discover that God blesses us through people. He's constantly bringing people into our lives to help us fulfill His purpose. We don't fulfill God's vision, mission, and purpose for our lives in a vacuum – we're part of a team bigger than ourselves."

If you're ready to integrate your Sunday beliefs with your Monday through Saturday workweek, this is your roadmap.
